If you are on the 2023 register and we have not gotten to your name, you MUST submit a new form to remain on the list.

- (4) If an eligible score is received on Maintenance Exam 955/718, applicants will then be scheduled for a Structured Interview.
- (5) If rated eligible on Structured Interview, applicant will be placed on In-Service Register (in score order).
- (6) Complete the Applicant Data Collection / Selection Sheet. The completed form must be received by, <u>March 31, 2024</u>.
